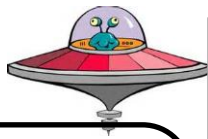


Literacy

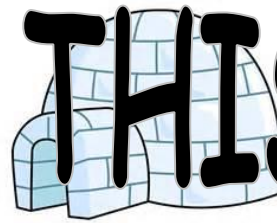
In DT the children will make a moving image. They will be following instructions and learning how to make joins.

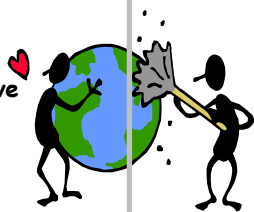
